We, the administration, faculty and parents of Dr. Leo G. Cigarroa High School do believe that our school must provide a curriculum of instruction which will help students achieve success and become contributing members in today's society.

1. Parents will be invited to attend monthly Parent Meetings (Meet and Greet) to inform them of the Title I School Wide Program, school goals and objectives, the Academic Excellence Indicator System (A.E.I.S.) results.
2. Teachers will provide timely student report cards for parents every nine (9) weeks and arrange parent conferences as needed.
3. Every student will receive two (2) timely student progress reports every three (3) weeks within the nine (9) week period to achieve student success.
4. Parents will be informed of curriculum mandates through Report Card Nights/Days and/or STARR sessions.
5. The school will implement an open door policy to discuss parent concerns.
6. The school will provide opportunities for parental engagement through a parents' survey given out at the beginning and at the end of the school year.
7. Parents will be encouraged to serve as parent volunteers, partake in Site-Based Decision Making System, and/or provide input in the development and operation of the school.
8. Parents volunteers will be advised of health requirements and other clearance procedures required by the school district.
9. Any communication with parents will be in a language the parents understand.
10. Parents will be encouraged to volunteer their time and talents to assist with campus activities.
