Eligibility Requirements

- Area high school junior or senior boy or girl
- Grade point average of at least 85 (4.5/6.0)
- Extra-curricular activity involvement
- United States Citizen

Application Requirements

- Society of Martha Washington application form with recent photograph
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher and/or counselor
- High School transcript
- Photocopy of first page of the previous year's 1040 Tax form filed by each parent in household
- One essay, minimum 350, maximum of 500 words on either topic:
 - Describe your outstanding achievement in depth and provide the specific planning, training, goals, and steps taken to make the accomplishment successful. Include details about your role and highlight leadership you provided.
 - Why would you like to go to Washington DC for the CloseUp program? What can you share with students from other places? What would you like to know about our government?
 - Patriotism
